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The Humanitarian Accountability Partnership (HAP) was originally developed for application in humanitarian relief programmes. The HAP standard is a practical and measureable tool that represents a broad consensus of what matters most of what humanitarian action. The standards help organizations to design, implement, assess, improve, recognize and accountable to programs. Being accountable to crisis-affected communities' it helps organizations to develop quality programs that meet those people's needs, and reduces the possibility of mistakes, abuse and corruption. PDI has developed a broacher to foster the HAP standards.

The HAP Principle is equipped with design, implement, assess, improve and recognize accountable programs. It outlines the policies, processes, procedures and practices that an organization needs in order to be accountable to crisis-affected communities. Efforts have been made to present HAP Principles in an easy and understandable way in the booklet
