Heavy monsoon rains fall from 7 to 11 September 2013 caused widespread losses to life, livelihood and infrastructure across the southern Punjab, northern Sindh and north eastern Balochistan. PDI being an advocacy organization decided to raise the issues of the flood affected communities in a proper and strategic way. For this purpose, PDI launched Peoples Accountability Commission on Floods (PACF) with its leadership from the flood affected communities.

PACF besides engaged in different other advocacy initiatives started collecting data about the flood related issues and preparing and disseminating reports as alternative pro poor reports. After having prepared, these reports were formally launched in media and media had been giving adequate coverage to those reports.

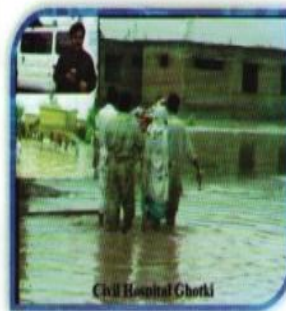
The research report is based on findings from the field perspective. The report includes flood damages updates, key flood related issues, Balochistan damage updates, amount allocation to districts and recommendations.
